Volunteer Information

Members are asked to volunteer services in whatever capacity is best suited to their abilities. It is important that GRRIN be able to call upon people whenever necessary, so please be thorough, accurate and realistic in filling out the information below. **Please circle the areas where you are interested in helping:**

Foster a Golden: Quality foster care represents the backbone of our program. Foster providers must complete a telephone interview and home visit. Providers must have a fenced area and agree to abide by all GRRIN policies and procedures. Foster care may last from two weeks to several months.

Rescue Committee: Volunteers committed to doing the day-to-day work of dog intake, prospective owner screening and foster home placement.

Phone Line Committee: Volunteers providing the first line of contact with the public. Responsible for responding to voice mail messages several weeks a year.

Publicity Committee: Volunteers willing to actively coordinate and participate in events to promote the mission of GRRIN.

Home Visits: Volunteers interested in prospective owner screening, completing a key interview step in the adoption process.

Transportation: Provide transportation to the vet and/or foster homes during the intake process.

Caseworker: Volunteers who follow a Golden through intake, fostering and permanent home placement. Provide support and knowledge to the foster home, maintain records, help coordinate the dog's adoption.
